Minutes of previous meeting – 13th January 2005

3. Matters arising

Highways issues – Concern was raised as to the signing used / lack of signing used to indicate the slippery nature of the roads. The consensus of the meeting was that the response by the highways authority was unhelpful and unsatisfactory. Through general debate it was determined that a group response should be sent to the highways authority requesting further consideration:

1. Permanent signs indicating a slippery road surface
2. Temporary signs indicating caution.

In each case could such signs be part funded locally? In relation to the temporary signs clarification is also sort on the liability of those involved in deploying or not deploying the signs.

Action

4. Site Operator Update – Augean

Complaints	There had been five complaints all relating to odour since. Two of them had not been in relation to the site. It was reported that there had been an 80% improvement in complaints between January - April 2004 and January - April 2005.
Systems	An improvement in vehicle cleaning was reported through the introduction of a further wheel washer and upgrade of the existing ones. Currently undergoing an ISO14001 audit and also going for an ISO for health and Safety in 2005.
Planning Application	Paul Blackler gave a presentation of the proposals soon to come forward as part of the planning application to regularise the current operations on the site. The application will cover various aspects <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Retention of existing buildings➤ Profiling and capping cessation of the MRF as no pre-treatment to occur on the site.➤ Phasing of operations➤ Hydrology➤ New monitoring wells -9 groundwater and 16 in total, which would be subject to Environment Agency control.➤ Landform➤ Landscaping➤ Highways – possible legal agreement➤ Noise –Secondary glazing funding offer letters had been sent.➤ Ecology➤ Air Quality➤ Health
Environmental schemes Action	Sponsorship of local schemes, cricket club, sports centre and walks Presentation to be circulated. Copy of the permit to Environmental Health Consider arranging a public meeting to discuss the application.

5. Environment Agency update

EA	All waste to be characterised under current system. Have regular visits to the site and have a continuing rolling programme of site visits The landfill directive for hazardous wastes will come into full force on July 16 th 2005.
