

# SITE RULES FOR EAST NORTHANTS RESOURCE MANAGEMENT FACILITY



## GENERAL

- The speed limit on site is **10** mph, apart from on the Soil Treatment Pad where the speed limit is **5** mph.
- High visibility clothing, hard hat and safety shoes must be worn at all times. In addition eye protection must be worn on the Soil Treatment Pad. Shorts **are not** acceptable on site.
- **No** young persons under the age of 18 are allowed on site.
- **NO** eating, drinking or smoking is permitted on site other than in the authorised areas
- Travel only on recognised side roads and take notice of all signs and obey all instructions.
- All vehicles, plant and equipment will be operated safely and only by suitably trained operators
- No vehicle or personnel should approach within three meters of a raised tipping face.
- All accidents must be reported to **an Augean member of staff** immediately.
- **Instructions given by Augean personnel must be followed at all times.**

## DRIVERS

**On arrival at site for the first time, drivers will be asked to confirm in writing their understanding and acceptance of these site rules.**

- The Soil Treatment pad operates a one on one off policy.
- Urinating any where on site, except within the toilets provided, is **forbidden**.
- Site signs provided by the weighbridge operator must be placed in windscreens prior to arriving in the disposal area.
- Drivers must remain within the confines of their vehicle at all times, other than when necessary for unloading, loading skips in a designated area or when directed to do so by site personnel.
- Loads being delivered **must be** secured by way of proper sheeting or netting, or be in a secured container, until discharged and only unsheeted in the designated area.
- Drivers will only tip their vehicles when instructed to do so by Augean personnel. To aid communication, our operators have CB radios, Channel 9.
- All tipper vehicles must have bodies lowered and tail gates secured before being driven. All skips/containers must be lowered onto the bed of the vehicle prior to being driven.
- All drivers must exercise extreme care when mounting and dismounting vehicles at all times.
- Drivers **are not** permitted to climb into the back of their vehicles to clean out by hand, unless agreed with the site management prior to arrival.

### **Before leaving the site:**

- All vehicles must use the spinner and wheel wash provided. You must remain in the high pressure washing system for the full 45 second cycle to allow for maximum effectiveness
- All loaded vehicles must be sheeted.
- Drivers must check their vehicles before leaving site to ensure that mud and debris is not taken out on to the highway.
- All HGV traffic must turn with **LEFT** when exiting the site.

## **VISITORS AND CONTRACTORS**

- All visitors and contractors must report to the weighbridge and each person is required to sign the visitors book.
- The footpath adjacent to the screen bund must be used at all times when entering or leaving the visitors car park.
- Contractors – A Site Induction, together with suitable risk assessments, method statements and permit to work are required before any work can commence.
- Contractors - Your whereabouts should be known to your Augean representative at all times.
- Visitors - Your Augean representative should accompany you throughout your visit to site.

### **Before leaving the site:**

- All visitors and contractors must return to the weighbridge and indicate they are leaving site, by signing out in the visitors book.
- Any PPE provided by Augean should be returned to the weighbridge office on departure.

**The above rules and procedures do not in any way supersede or take precedence over the legal and contractual requirements that relate to the operation of particular sites.**
