## Introductory note

### ***This introductory note does not form a part of the permit***

The following notice, which is issued pursuant to regulation 20 and Part 1 of Schedule 5 of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations S.I.2007 No. 3538 (the Regulations), gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit to operate a regulated facility/facilities.

The changes introduced by this variation notice are to include a further treatment (Shredding of full waste containers), to increase the number of European Waste Catalogue (EWC) codes accepted at site and to increase the storage time prior to processing to 72 hours.

Schedule 1 of this notice lists any deleted conditions, Schedule 2 lists any amended conditions and Schedule 3 lists any conditions that have been added.

The following conditions are amended as follows;

1. **Table 1.1** The inclusion of Shredding of Full Waste Containers as additional treatment. No more than 50t per day of material to be shredded
  
2. **Table 1.1** The storage of putrescible waste is to be increased to 72 hours prior to processing

### **Schedule 2 section 1.2.1**

Waste types listed in Annex 1 of this variation notice are to be added to the existing list of permitted waste types.

### **Schedule 3 – conditions to be added**

The following conditions are added;

- 4.1.1 To prevent contamination from potentially infectious material additional EWC codes 18 01 04 and 18 02 03, a producer audit shall be conducted in accordance with the requirements of Appendix 6 Sector Guidance Note IPPC S5.06 and any subsequent amendments.
