

Site Rules

PAISLEY TREATMENT AND TRANSFER CENTRE



GENERAL

- Mobile phones **MUST** be switched off while on site.
- **NO** eating, drinking or smoking is permitted on site other than in authorised areas.
- **NO** young persons under the age of 18 are allowed on site.
- Shorts are **NOT** acceptable on site
- Maximum speed limit on site is **5** mph.
- All accidents must be reported to **Reception** immediately.
- All near misses must be reported to **Reception** who will record the event in the site near miss book
- Instructions given by operational personnel must be followed at all times.
- The fire alarm system will be tested every **Tuesday at 10am** unless instructed by a member of Augean staff you do not need to take any action.
- At the sound of the fire alarm or by direction of site management in an emergency, exit any building by the nearest fire escape. Leave site by the closest gate and turn right. **DO NOT** cross the road unless directed to do so by a fire marshal. The muster point is located outside Iveco.

VISITORS AND CONTRACTORS

- All visitors and contractors to the site must report to Reception on arrival.
- Contractors - Your whereabouts should be known to your Augean representative at all times.
- Visitors - Your Augean representative should accompany you throughout your visit to site.
- Without exception you are required to wear long sleeved overalls; eye protection, hard hat; gloves; and Hi-Vis vest/jacket at all times when offloading, loading or handling waste on site. Certain areas or tasks may require additional PPE. This will be advised.

Before leaving the site:

- All visitors, contractors and drivers must return to the area they signed in and report out

DRIVERS

On arrival at site for the first time, drivers will be asked to confirm in writing their understanding and acceptance of these site rules.

- All drivers must report to the weighbridge on arrival at the site.
- You are required to wear long sleeved overalls, gloves, safety boots/shoes, hard hat, eye protection and Hi-Vis vest/jacket at all times when offloading, loading or handling waste on site. Certain areas or tasks may require additional PPE. This will be advised accordingly
- Waste can only be discharged to the site under the supervision of an authorised Augean employee.
- Waste can only be unloaded in the designated area for that waste stream. Under no circumstances are vehicles to be unloaded on public roads.
- Any spillage must be cleared up and reported to site management without delay.
- All vehicles, plant and equipment will be operated in a manner showing due care and attention to safety, having regard to all circumstances at the time.

The above rules and procedures do not in any way supersede or take precedence over the legal and contractual requirements that relate to the operation of particular sites.
