



# SITE RULES FOR ROCHDALE TRANSFER CENTRE

## **GENERAL**

- **No Smoking is permitted** on site – the designated smoking area will be identified during the site induction.
- **No** eating or drinking is permitted on site other than in designated areas identified during site induction
- Fire alarm testing is carried out in the office at 11:00am every Thursday. If you hear the alarm outside this time, take it as a real incident.
- All vehicles, plant and equipment will be operated in a manner showing due care and attention to safety, having regard to all circumstances at the time.
- All accidents/near misses must be reported to reception immediately.
- Instructions given by Augean personnel must be followed at all times.

## **DRIVERS**

**On arrival at site for the first time, drivers will be asked to confirm in writing their understanding and acceptance of these site rules.**

- Drivers must gain authorization prior to entry onto site.
- You are required to wear overalls, gloves, safety boots/shoes, hard hat, eye protection and Hi-Vis vest/jacket at all times when offloading, loading or handling waste on site. Certain areas or tasks may require additional PPE.
- All drivers must exercise extreme care when mounting and dismounting vehicles.

### **Before leaving the site:**

- All loaded vehicles must be secure and have all paperwork signed by the on site chemist.

## **VISITORS AND CONTRACTORS**

- All visitors and contractors to the site must report to reception in the main office.
- All visitors and contractors shall receive a site induction which will be reviewed periodically
- Visitors - Your Augean representative should accompany you throughout your visit.
- Contractors - Your Augean representative should know your whereabouts at all times.
- Contractors – all tasks must have been approved prior to performing them and documented RAMS supplied where necessary

### **Before leaving the site:**

- All visitors and contractors must return to reception and report out.
