

## **SITE RULES FOR WORCESTER TREATMENT CENTRE**

### **GENERAL**

- Only diesel engine vehicles are permitted on site.
- Mobile phones **MUST** be switched off while on site.
- **No** eating, drinking or smoking is permitted on site other than in authorised areas.
- **No** young persons under the age of 18 are allowed on site.
- Shorts are **not** acceptable on site
- Maximum speed limit on site is **10** mph.
- All vehicles, plant and equipment will be operated in a manner showing due care and attention to safety, having regard to all circumstances at the time.
- All accidents must be reported to the **Reception** immediately.
- Instructions given by operational personnel must be followed at all times.

### **DRIVERS**

**On arrival at site for the first time, drivers will be asked to confirm in writing their understanding and acceptance of these site rules.**

- All skips **must be sheeted** on arrival and exit. Un-sheeted loads will be reported to the Site Manager.
- All drivers must report to the site office/reception on arrival at the site.
- You are required to wear overalls, gloves, safety boots/shoes, hard hat, eye protection and Hi-Vis vest/jacket at all times when offloading, loading or handling waste on site. Certain areas or tasks may require additional PPE.

### **VISITORS AND CONTRACTORS**

- On arrival visitors and contractors should report to reception in the main office.
- Contractors - Your Augean representative should know your whereabouts at all times.
- Visitors - Your Augean representative should accompany you throughout your visit to site.
- Without exception you are required to wear eye protection, hard hat and Hi-Vis vest/jacket at all times when offloading, loading or handling waste on site. Certain areas or tasks may require additional PPE.

#### **Before leaving the site:**

- All visitors and contractors must return to reception and report out.
