

## **SITE RULES FOR EAST NORTANTS RESOURCE MANAGEMENT FACILITY**

### **GENERAL**

- The speed limit on site is **10** mph
- High visibility clothing, hard hat and safety shoes must be worn at all times.
- **No** young persons under the age of 18 are allowed on site.
- Shorts are **not** acceptable on site
- **No smoking** on site – smoking is permitted only in the “smoking hut” at the back of the canteen.
- No vehicle or personnel should approach within three meters of a raised tipping face.
- All accidents must be reported to the **Weighbridge Office** immediately.
- Instructions given by operational personnel must be followed at all times.

### **DRIVERS**

**On arrival at site for the first time, drivers will be asked to confirm in writing their understanding and acceptance of these site rules.**

- Drivers must remain within the confines of their vehicle at all times, other than when necessary for unloading, loading skips in a designated area or when directed to do so by site personnel.
- Loads being delivered must be secured by way of proper sheeting or netting, or be in a secured container, until discharged.
- All drivers must exercise extreme care when mounting and dismounting vehicles at all times.
- All tipper vehicles must have bodies lowered and tail gates secured before being driven. All skips/containers must be lowered onto the bed of the vehicle prior to being driven.

**Before leaving the site:**

- All vehicles must use the spinner and wheel wash provided.
- All loaded vehicles must be sheeted.
- All HGV traffic must turn with **LEFT** when exiting the site.

## **VISITORS**

- All pedestrian visitors to the site must report to weighbridge.
- The footpath adjacent to the weighbridge must be used at all times.
- Your Augean representative should accompany you throughout your visit to site.

### **Before leaving the site:**

- All visitors must return to the weighbridge and report out.

The above rules and procedures do not in any way supersede or take precedence over the legal and contractual requirements that relate to the operation of particular sites.
